Activity R2A: Listing Pronouns

WARM-UP ACTIVITY

Materials Longman Preparation Course for the TOEFL iBT® Test iBT®. 3E

The purpose of this activity is to introduce **Reading Skill 2: RECOGNIZE** REFERENTS.

Before class:

No preparation is necessary.

In class:

- 1. Divide the class into groups of 3–4. Then ask students in each group to work together for 3 minutes to list all the pronouns they know.
- **2.** Go over the answers with the class.

Possible answers

Subject pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they

Object pronouns: me, you, him, her, it, us, them

Possessive pronouns: mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs

Reflexive pronouns: myself, yourself, himself, herself, ourselves,

yourselves, themselves

Relative pronouns: who, which, that, what

Demonstrative pronouns: this, that, these, those

Quantifiers: one, some, none, many, much, a few, a lot, a little (other

quanitifiers could be used as pronouns)

Optional: Turn this activity into a competition by adding 1 point for each correctly listed pronoun and subtracting 1 point for each incorrectly listed pronoun.
